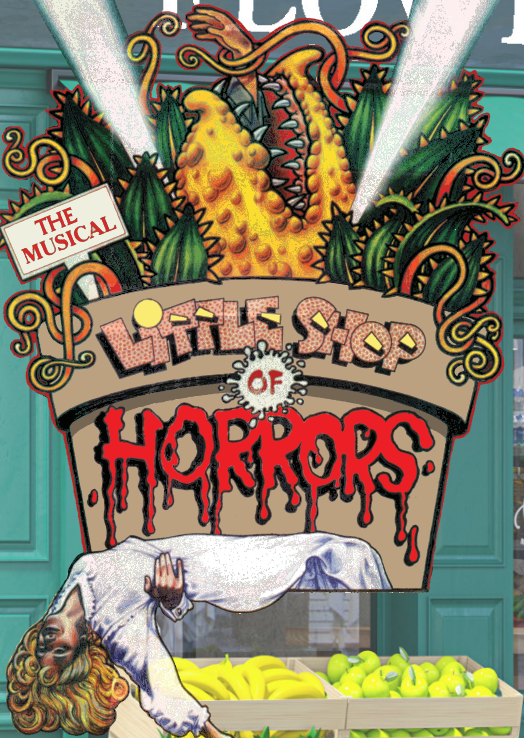

How does one develop a “character,” especially for a production like *Little Shop of Horrors*?

Well, from two Directors’ points of view, you start like any other show. Where are we; When are we; Who are we; and What are our relationships to others? Add in the fact that this is a “sci fi” thriller with a “twist” AND a love story to boot and oh my!

The first thing we worked on was the “street gangs”—the nine girl gang members on stage. They were an interesting and creative challenge. With their help, we developed a “story” if you will. First, they are all from Skid Row and have nothing except what their wits can provide. Where do they live? Which tenement is theirs? Are any of them related, e.g. do they have a sister in a rival gang? From these starting points, individual characters began to emerge—how they dressed, how they spoke, and how they moved! They got input from the Directors, the Choreographer, the Musical Director, and the Costumer. And voilà! Then we added in the overall story line, an alien plant from outer space, their coming together for a common goal, and Bang, Zowie, a powerful, well-rounded and wonderful sounding “Greek” chorus of powerful individuals! What a great bunch of characters!
