Brian LaPalme - Make Up Artist

Brian was allowed to graduate Windham High School in Willimantic, CT, one month early in order to start his career in show business. Brian had two concurrent careers. Eight months of every year from 1976 to 2018, Brian was Ringmaster/Magician with circuses throughout the U.S. and Canada. During the remaining four months of every year, Brian worked as a theatrical makeup artist for stage shows like *The Wizard of OZ*, *Phantom of the Opera*, *Cats*, and hundreds of others. Now that Brian is retired from life on the road, he still performs as a Mentalist from time to time in The Villages, as well as doing makeup for Villages theatrical productions. Brian's first time working with SMASH was for *The Honeymooners from New York to The Villages*, and he is excited to work on this show. Whatever he is doing, he embraces the philosophy of "There's No Business Like Show Business!"
